Guidelines for Cafeteria Meal Charges

General Guidelines

1. South Allegheny School District is using a Point of Sale system which lists all students in the district by name and category (paid, reduced, free).
2. Parents/Guardians are solely responsible for providing their children with money for lunch, or packing a lunch from home. If for any reason, a parent cannot afford to provide a lunch for their child, free and reduced lunch applications are available in the school offices.
3. The Cafeteria Service will maintain a record of students who charge meals and notify building principals accordingly.

Elementary K-3 Guidelines

1. Students in grades K-3 will not be denied a meal for any reason.
2. After three (3) charges to the student's account, he/she will receive peanut butter and jelly, fruit, vegetable and milk at his/her current meal price.
3. Parents will be notified through a charge notice send home with the student and will be responsible for all meal charges.

Grades 4, 5 and 6 Guidelines

1. No student will be permitted to carry more than three (3) unpaid charges at any time. These charged meals will consist of peanut butter and jelly, fruit, vegetable and milk only.
2. No meal will be served after three (3) charges.
3. To prevent a student from not receiving a lunch, parents will be notified of each charged meal through a charge notice given to the student.

Middle School – 7th & 8th Grade

1. No student will be permitted to carry more than two (2) unpaid, charges at any time. These charged meals will consist of cheese sandwich, fruit, vegetable and milk only.
2. No meal will be served after two (2) charges.
3. Parents will be notified of each charged meal to prevent a student from not receiving a lunch.

High School – 9th, 10th, 11th, & 12th Grade

1. No student will be permitted to carry more than one (1) unpaid charge at any time. This charged meal will consist of cheese sandwich, fruit, vegetable and milk only.
2. No meal will be served after one (1) charge.
3. Parents will be notified of the charged meal to prevent a student from not receiving a lunch.
